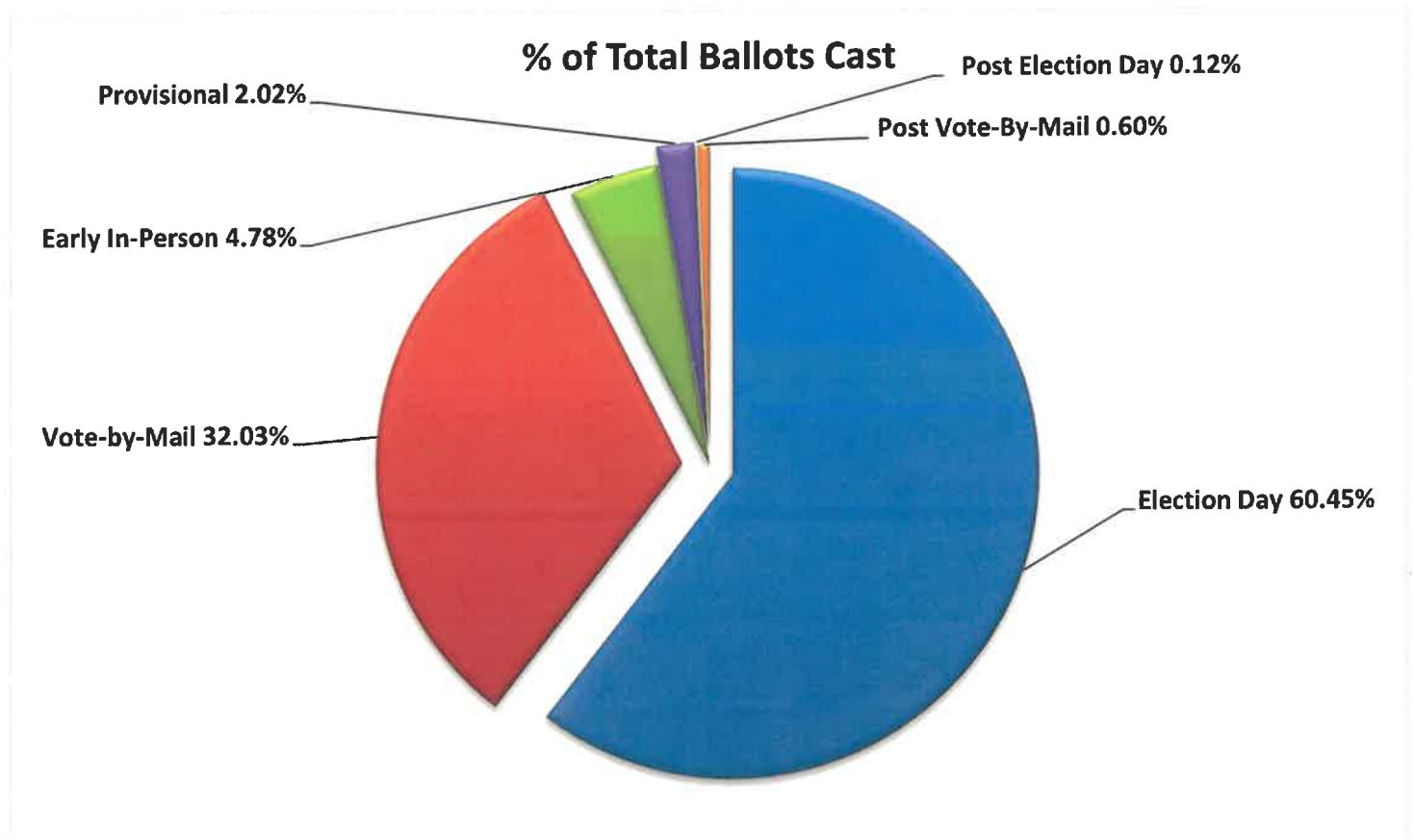
## FINAL RESULTS

## SUMMARY OF OFFICIAL CANVASS

There were a total of 416,339 ballots tabulated for the November 8, 2022, General Election. Below is a breakdown of the ballots counted by category and a percentage of the total vote by category.

## VOTE-BY-MAIL/EARLY IN-PERSON SUMMARY

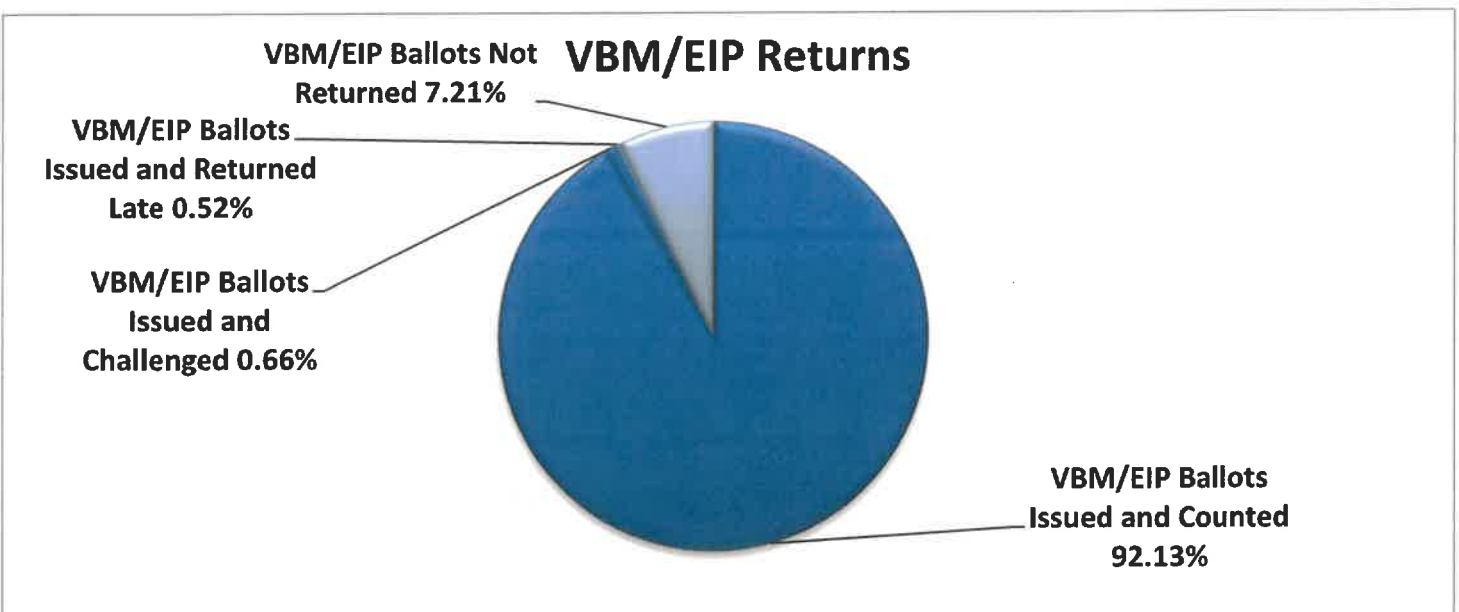
A total of 169,191 ballots were issued during Vote-by-Mail and Early In-Person voting. Of those ballots, 155,869 (92.13%) were returned and counted by the Ballot Department. There were 1,120 challenged or late VBM/EIP ballots, resulting in a 0.71%\* Challenge Rate for this election.

\*The Challenge Rate is 0.16% when voters who returned their ballot late are excluded.

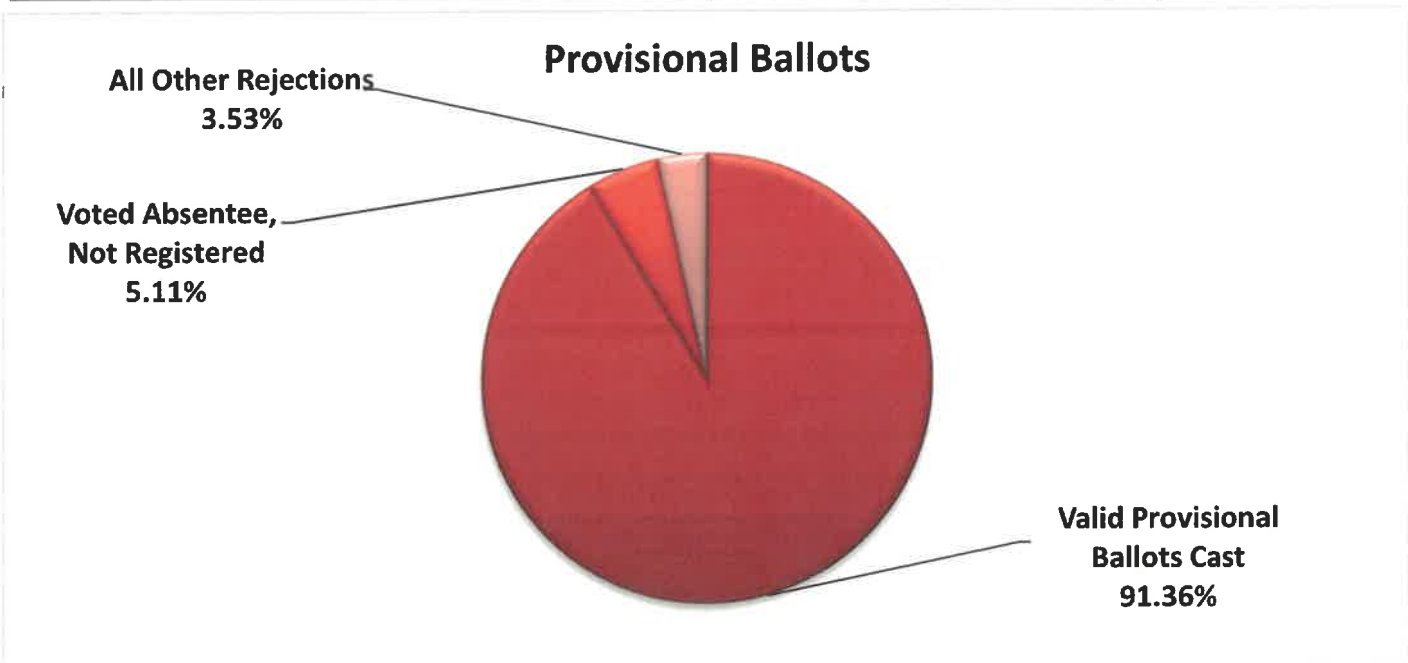


## PROVISIONAL VOTING SUMMARY

A total of 9,201 Provisional Ballots were cast during the November 8, 2022, General Election. Of those ballots, 8,406 (91.36%) were valid and tabulated by the Ballot Department. There were 795 invalid Provisional Ballots, resulting in a 8.64%\* rejection rate for this election.

\*The Provisional Rejection Rate is 3.53% when provisional voters who have already cast a VBM Ballot or are Not Registered are excluded.

## BALLOT REMAKES

During the election, 4,074 ballot sheets were processed in accordance with the CCBOE Remake Policy (approved by the Board on May 17, 2013). The overall remake rate for this election was 1.193%. Excluding UOCAVA & Voted For Ineligible Contest, the remake rate for this election was 0.556%.

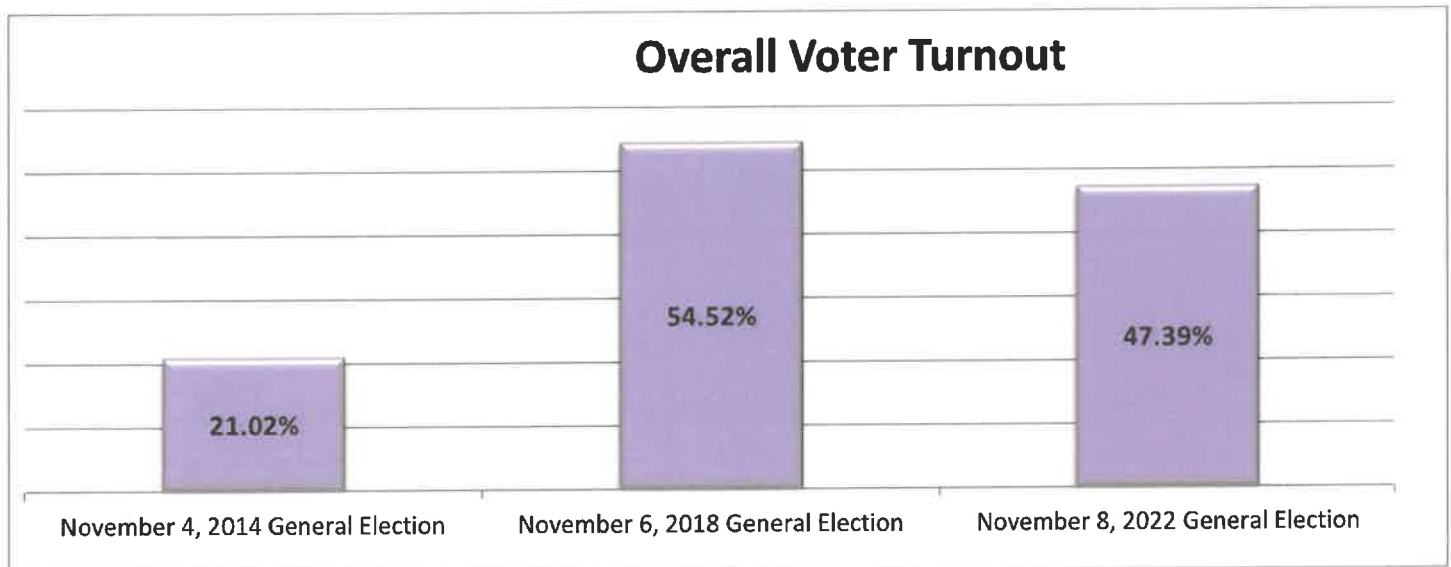

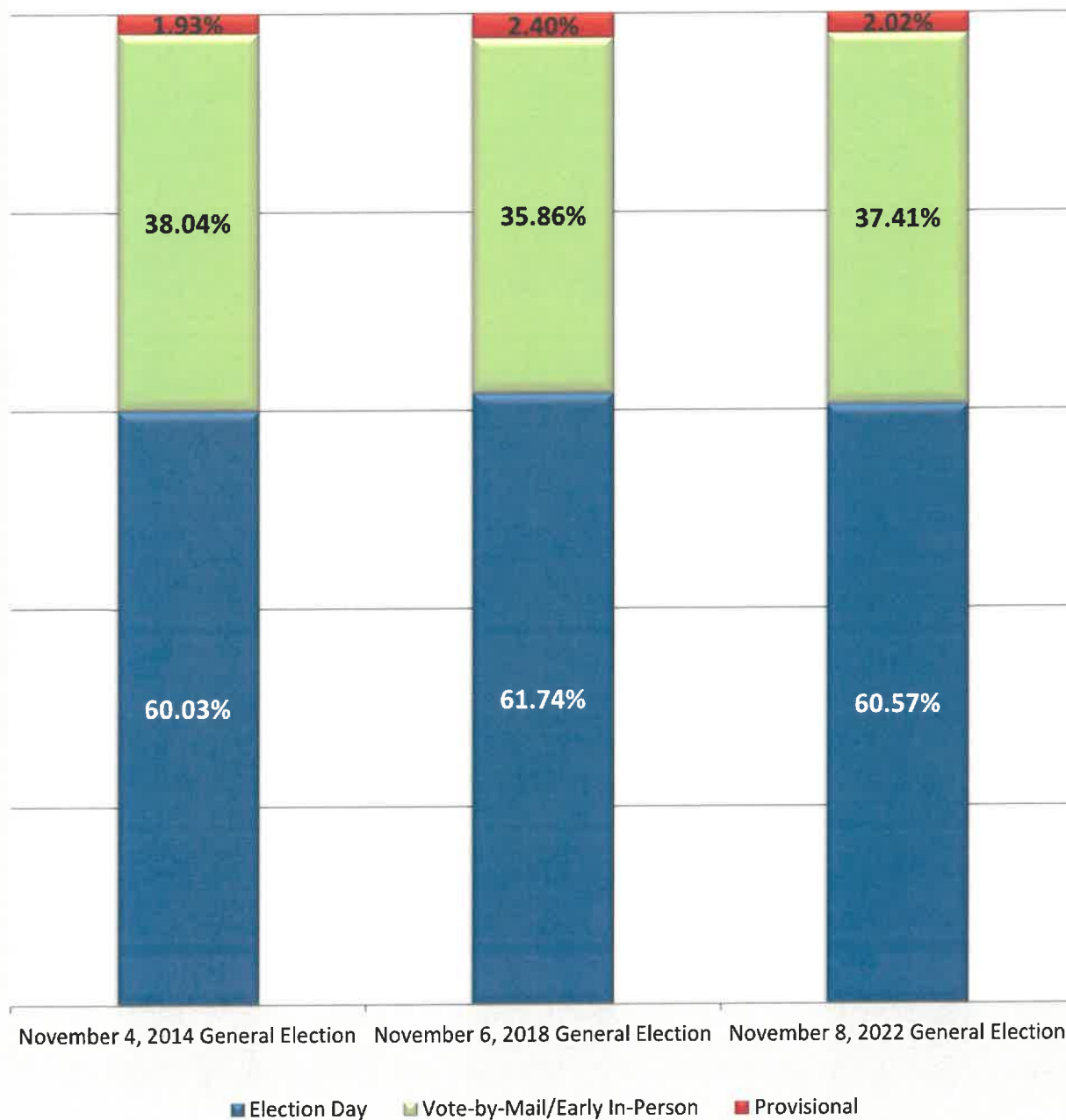

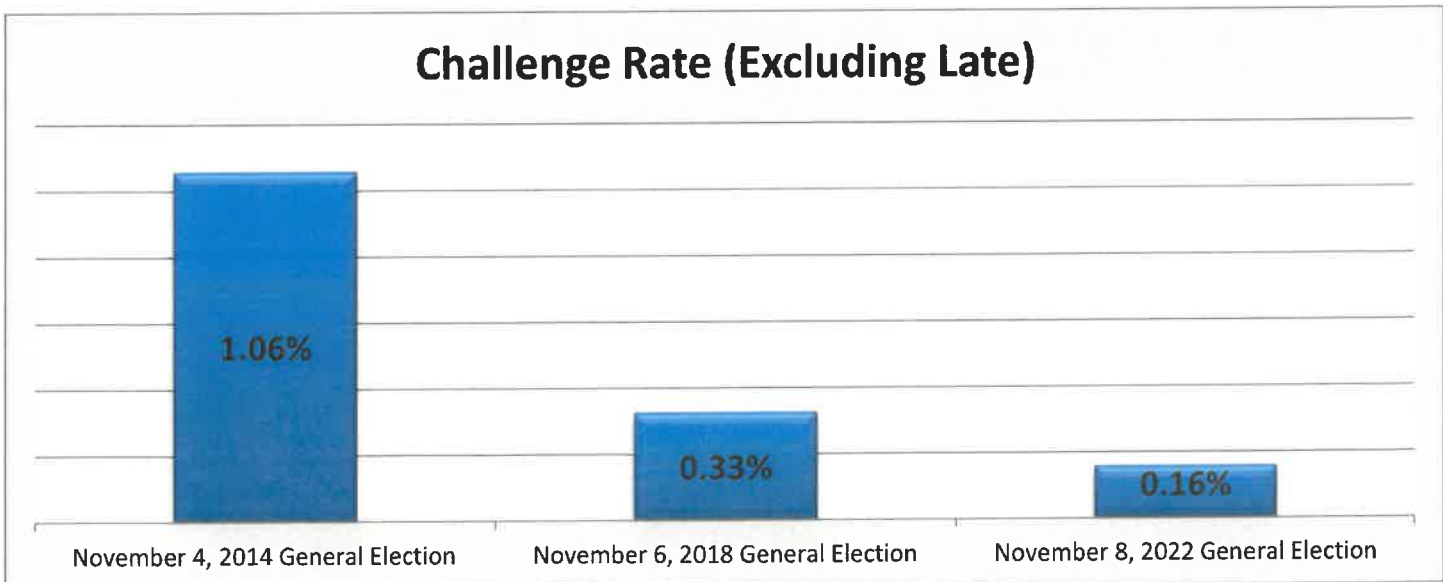

### Voter Turnout by Category



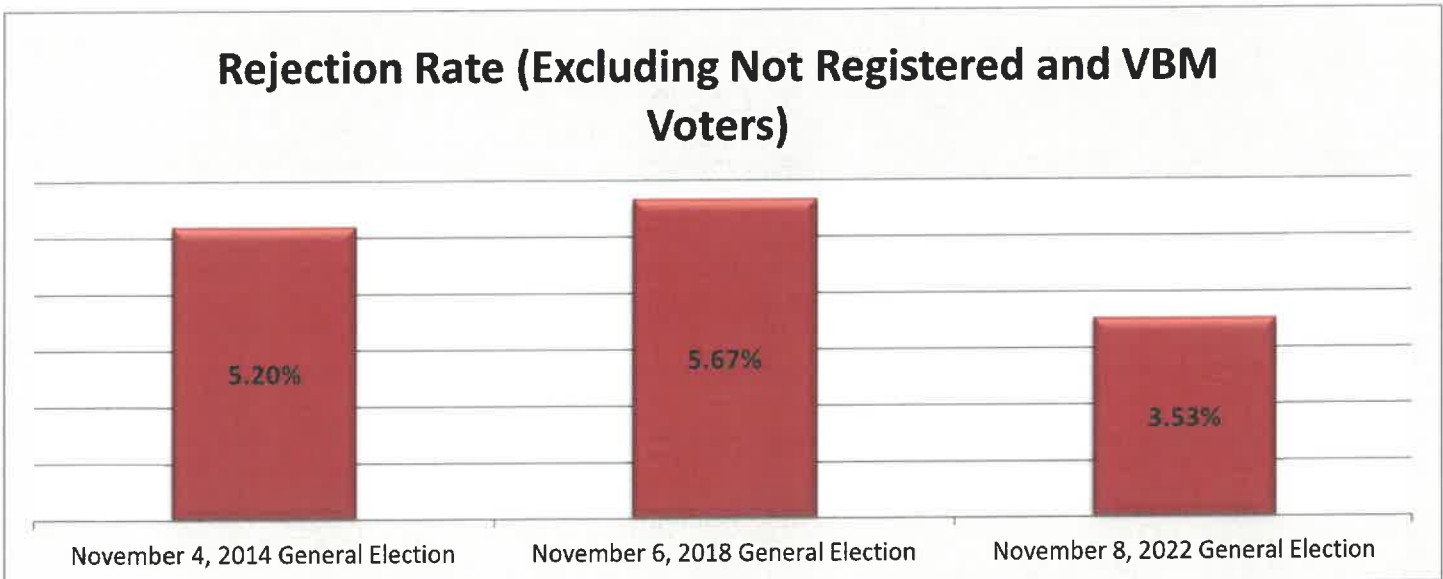
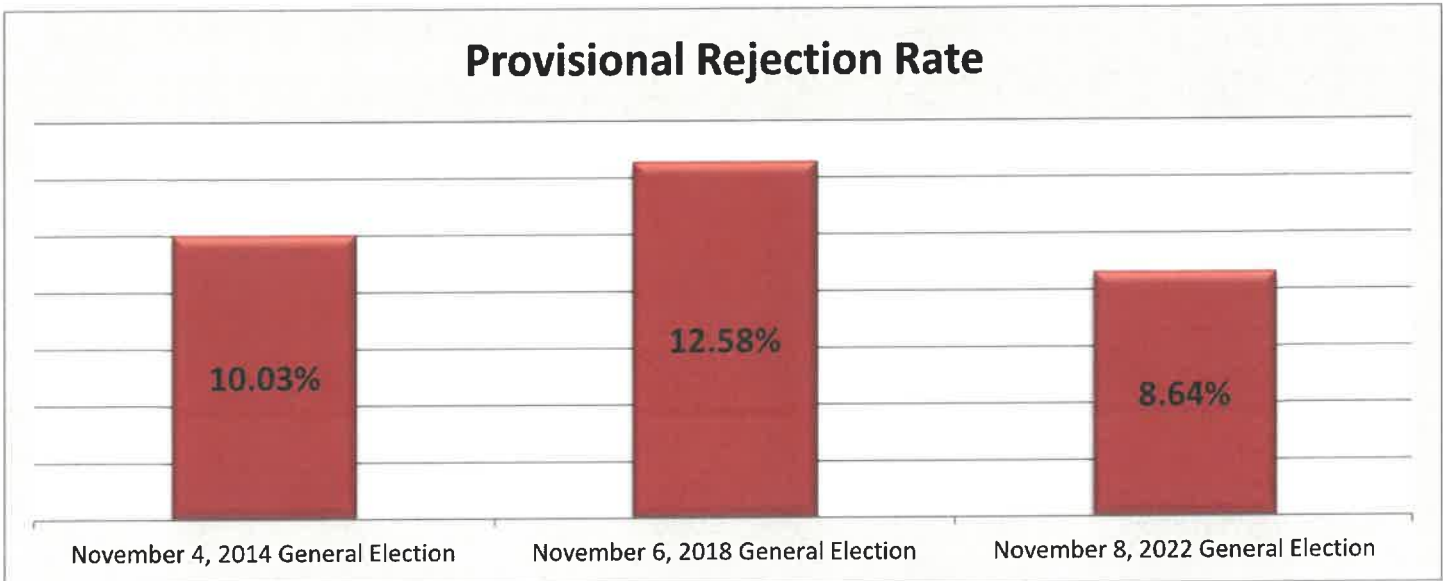
