The Cuyahoga County Board of Elections Meeting began at 9:28 a.m. Hereinafter referred to as the CCBOE/Board.

Chairman Hastings noted that Board Members Davis Chappell and Stickan were in attendance in person. Board Member Wondolowski was excused from today's meeting.

Chairman Hastings moved to excuse Board Member Wondolowski's absence. Board Member Davis Chappell seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

**Agenda Item 1: Approval of the minutes from the August 16, 2021, and August 23, 2021, Board Meetings.**

Chairman Hastings moved to approve the minutes from the August 16, 2021, Board Meeting, Board Member Stickan seconded. Board Member Davis Chappell abstained. Chairman Hastings and Board Member Stickan approved the minutes. Chairman Hastings moved to approve the minutes from the August 23, 2021, Board Meeting. Board Member Stickan seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

**Agenda Item 2: Acknowledgment of Secretary of State Advisory and Directives: Advisory 2021-03: S.B. 80 and Am. Sub. H.B. 110 (134<sup>th</sup> General Assembly); Directive 2021-18: Ballots for November 2, 2021, General Election; Directive 2021-19: General Voter Records Maintenance Program.**

Director Perlatti commented concerning the Directive 2021-19: General Voter Record Maintenance Program. The directive has Boards of Elections mailing out notices on September 20<sup>th</sup>. The CCBOE has received a 10 day extension from the Secretary of State. Due to the September 14<sup>th</sup> election the extension to September 30<sup>th</sup> will give the CCBOE time to complete voter history and process provisional information.

Chairman Hastings moved to acknowledge the Secretary of State Advisory and Directives: Advisory 2021-03: S.B. 80 and Am. Sub. H.B. 110 (134<sup>th</sup> General Assembly); Directive 2021-18: Ballots for

**Agenda Item 9: Preliminary authorization for the allocation of voting booths for November 2, 2021, General Election. Allocation quantities are based on Social Distancing and room size per polling location. A total of 4,592 voting booths will be allocated + 838 DS200 precinct scanners + 157 ADA AutoMark voting units and 1,128 Electronic Poll books.**

Chairman Hastings moved to acknowledge the preliminary authorization for the allocation of voting booths for November 2, 2021, General Election. Allocation quantities are based on Social Distancing and room size per polling location. A total of 4,592 voting booths will be allocated + 838 DS200 precinct scanners + 157 ADA AutoMark voting units and 1,128 Electronic Poll books. Board Member Davis Chappell seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

**Agenda Item 10: Approval to send the Voter Information Guide to all active voters for the November 2, 2021, General Election.**

Chairman Hastings moved to approve to send the Voter Information Guide to all active voters for the November 2, 2021, General Election. Board Member Davis Chappell seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Chairman Hastings moved to approve the vouchers. Board Member Davis Chappell seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

**Agenda Item 12: Personnel Agenda**

Chairman Hastings moved to approve the personnel agenda. Board Member Davis Chappell seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

### **CCBOE Website Update**

Director Perlatti provided an update of the CCBOE website update. The CCBOE is working with the County Information Systems (IS) department to implement the new website. Testing and proofing on the user interface with mobile phones are ongoing. The date of Tuesday, September 15, 2021, has been agreed upon between the CCBOE and County IS to determine if the website will go "live" before November or delay the implementation until after the November Election. If the current issues are resolved by September 14th, the CCBOE will go "live" on September 27, 2021. Board Member Davis Chappell asked if there were many issues to be resolved by the September 15th deadline. Director Perlatti stated no, according to the CCBOE IS employees, the issues could be resolved within the timeframe. Chairman Hastings asked if the new site goes "live" and there are issues, could the old site be brought back up again. Director Perlatti stated yes. Chairman Hastings asked if the SOS office is aware the new website will be compliant with the SOS cyber security requirements and regulations. Director Perlatti said yes, and the updated website will meet all the links required by the SOS. Board Member Davis Chappell stated she is looking forward to a more user-friendly site.

**Update on investigation regarding altered circulator statements for Landry M. Simmons, Jr.** Deputy Director Kaloger provided an update on the investigation regarding the altered circulator statements for Landry M. Simmons, Jr. The CCBOE staff interviewed individuals involved with the Landry Simmons petitions, including the circulators and quality assurance. The Landry campaign paid the circulators based on the number of Cleveland resident's signatures were received. The campaign's quality assurance team would cross-off any non-residents of Cleveland and change the circulator statement on the petitions with the adjusted number. There were also instances on the circulator statements where the space for the number of signatures was left blank, but an altered number was written in and initialed. The changes to the circulator statements invalidated many of the part-petitions. Chairman Hastings stated that it appears the motivation for the changes was to save money. Deputy Director Kaloger agreed and stated that the campaign should have tracked the valid signature information separately and not altered the petitions. When these 14-part petitions were changed or completed incorrectly; it caused those part petitions not to be counted. Chairman Hastings asked if the campaign submitted these altered petitions and Deputy Director Kaloger stated yes. Because of these invalid petitions the CCBOE determined the candidate did not have enough valid signatures, which caused Landry Simmons, Jr. to withdraw his name from the ballot. Chairman Hastings stated that based on the foregoing investigation, he is not requesting this matter be referred to the Cuyahoga County Prosecutor's office. Board Member Davis Chappell noted the investigation was thorough, and the campaign staff was cooperative in the investigation. It is evident that the campaign did not understand what they were doing but was not acting with improper motivation, intent, or purpose. In addition, Mr. Simmons withdrew his name from the ballot. Board Member Davis Chappell is not in favor of referring the matter to the Prosecutor's office. Board Member Stickan stated the investigation was thorough, and it is not necessary for any further hearing on the matter. Chairman Hastings stated the CCBOE Board considers the matter closed.

### **September 14, 2021, Primary Election Update**

Director Perlatti stated voter participation is exceeding expectations. Based on the absentee numbers from early in-person and vote-by-mail, the turn-out could be in the ballpark of 20 percent. Through Sunday, September 12, 2021, the CCBOE had just under 3,000 early-in-person voters, and today is the last day for voting in-person at the CCBOE. The request for ballot application deadline was noon on Saturday, September 11. The CCBOE has processed 21,303 vote-by-mail applications. The CCBOE has received over 15,000 mail-in ballots, a 72% return. The recruitment of precinct election officials continues to be a challenge, but the CCBOE has enough workers for Election Day. There are over 1,500 individuals trained, and the call-offs have been minimal. The average worker per precinct is 3.5 people, along with a pool of stand-by workers. Election support is working with Berman's Moving to complete the delivery of voting equipment today. The Cuyahoga County Command Center is being used as the call center staffed with a representative from the power company, Sherriff's office, and Public Works. The number of staff for election night at the warehouse is comparable to the August Special Election. The CCBOE is prepared and ready for Election Day. Chairman Hastings asked how many precincts were involved in the Election. Director Perlatti stated 442 precincts.

### **PUBLIC COMMENT**

Ms. Peg Gallagher and Judge C. Ellen Connally provided public comment on Kenneth L. Johnson's eligibility to run for City of Cleveland Council, Ward 4.

Chairman Hastings moved to recess the meeting at 10:30 a.m. Board Member Davis Chappell seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

## SUMMARY

- Advisory 2021-04 explains how the results of the 2020 federal decennial census may impact municipal corporations (cities and villages), petition signature requirements for city school district candidates, and the redistricting of congressional and state legislative districts.
- Cuyahoga County is now the second-largest county in Ohio with a population of 1,264,817. This is a slight decrease from 2010, when we had a population of 1,280,122. Franklin County is the largest county with a population of 1,323,807.
- Cuyahoga County does not have any municipalities changing status (from village to city or vice versa).
- The legislative authority of a city is responsible for subdividing the city into wards within 90 days after the first day of October 2021.
- Ohio is losing one congressional district (16 to 15). The Ohio Redistricting Commission must realign the boundaries of the state's House of Representatives and Senate districts, but the total number of these districts will not change.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### **I. MUNICIPAL RECLASSIFICATION**

Municipal corporations that have a population of 5,000 or more are cities; all others are villages.

### **II. CHARTERED MUNICIPALITY STATUS**

Some provisions of this Advisory may not apply to a municipal corporation that adopted a charter containing provisions that differ from the ORC.

### **III. TYPE OF ELECTION TO BE HELD**

The change in a municipal corporation's status (from a village to a city or vice versa) should not affect the type of elections held in the municipal corporation (i.e., primary or nonpartisan election). If a municipal corporation's status is changing, candidates for municipal office will file for office in the same way they would have filed for office if the municipal corporation's status were not changing.

### **IV. OFFICERS TO BE ELECTED**

Officers of a village advancing to a city, or of a city reducing to a village, "shall continue in office until succeeded by the proper officers of the new municipal corporation at the regular municipal election, and the ordinances thereof not inconsistent with the laws relating to the new municipal corporation shall continue in force until changed or repealed."

### **V. OFFICE OF MUNICIPAL COURT CLERK**

The clerk of a municipal court is an elected position if the population of the territory served by the court equals or exceeds 100,000; however, if the population of the territory served by the court is less than 100,000, the position is appointed. The 2020 federal decennial census results may change a clerk's position from an appointed position to an elected position.



## **VI. CITY WARDS**

According to R.C. 731.06, the legislative authority of a city is responsible for subdividing the city into wards within 90 days after the first day of October following the federal decennial census year. [This would occur in the period of October-December 2021.](#)

## **VII. CITY SCHOOL DISTRICTS**

The minimum number of valid signatures for candidate petitions for a city school district board of education is based upon the total population of the city school district. [The Secretary of State provided a spreadsheet showing the population of all school districts in Ohio after the completion of the 2020 federal decennial census.](#)

## **VIII. CENSUS BLOCKS**

A board of elections may divide any portion of a political subdivision located within its county into precincts (along census block lines). However, a board cannot change the number of precincts or the precinct boundaries during the 25 days immediately preceding a primary or general election, nor between January 1 and the day on which the members of a county central committee of a political party are elected (*i.e.*, May 3, 2022).

A board of elections may apply in writing to the SOS for a waiver of the census block requirement if drawing precinct boundaries by census blocks is not feasible for either of the following reasons:

1. Physical boundaries or residential development practices exist that would cause unusual hardship for voters; or
2. A precinct would contain more than 1,400 voters.

## **IX. FEDERAL AND STATE REDISTRICTING**

As a result of the 2020 federal decennial census, Ohio is losing one congressional district (reduced from 16 to 15 districts). Article XIX of the Ohio Constitution gives the General Assembly primary responsibility for congressional redistricting. The Ohio Constitution sets a series of deadlines for the congressional redistricting process, the earliest of which is September 30, 2021.

According to Article XI of the Ohio Constitution, the Ohio Redistricting Commission must realign the boundaries of the state's House of Representatives and Senate districts. The total number of members of the Ohio House of Representatives and Senate will not change.

Re: Results and Impact of 2020 Federal Decennial Census

**SUMMARY**

On August 12, 2021, the United States Census Bureau released the official results of the 2020 federal decennial census. This Advisory explains how the results may impact municipal corporations (cities and villages), petition signature requirements for city school district candidates, and the redistricting of congressional and state legislative districts.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

**I. MUNICIPAL RECLASSIFICATION**

Pursuant to the Ohio Constitution and Ohio Revised Code, municipal corporations are classified into cities and villages. Municipal corporations that have a population of 5,000 or more are cities; all others are villages.<sup>1</sup> The Secretary of State will issue proclamations declaring the population of all municipal corporations based on the official results of the 2020 federal decennial census.<sup>2</sup> As a result of the 2020 federal decennial census, some municipal corporations must be reclassified (from city to village or from village to city). Classifications of municipalities will become official 30 days after the Secretary of State issues the proclamations.<sup>3</sup> When a city's classification reverts to a village because of the federal decennial census results, the city may conduct an enumeration pursuant to [R.C. 703.02](#). All questions regarding the process of enumeration should be directed to the city law director or the legislative authority of the city.

Accompanying this Advisory is a Microsoft Excel workbook containing the following information: (1) a list of the population of each county, city, village, township, and school district in the state and (2) a list of cities and villages that are changing classification.

**II. CHARTERED MUNICIPALITY STATUS**

Some provisions of this Advisory may not apply to a municipal corporation that adopted a charter containing provisions that differ from the Ohio Revised Code. Accordingly, candidates for municipal office in a chartered municipality must review the municipality's charter.

### **III. TYPE OF ELECTION TO BE HELD**

The change in a municipal corporation's status (from a village to a city or vice versa) should not affect the type of elections held in the municipal corporation (i.e., primary or nonpartisan election).<sup>4</sup> If a municipal corporation's status is changing, candidates for municipal office should file for office in the same manner that they would have filed for office if the municipal corporation's status were not changing (i.e., declaration of candidacy or nominating petition).

### **IV. OFFICERS TO BE ELECTED**

According to [R.C. 703.07](#), officers of a village advancing to a city, or of a city reducing to a village, "shall continue in office until succeeded by the proper officers of the new municipal corporation at the regular municipal election, and the ordinances thereof not inconsistent with the laws relating to the new municipal corporation shall continue in force until changed or repealed." Accordingly, officers elected at the November 2021 General Election will be the officers of a city, if a village is advancing to a city, or the officers of a village, if a city is reducing to a village.<sup>5</sup>

### **V. OFFICE OF MUNICIPAL COURT CLERK**

Except as otherwise provided in [R.C. 1901.31](#), the clerk of a municipal court is an elected position if the population of the territory served by the court equals or exceeds 100,000; however, if the population of the territory served by the court is less than 100,000, the position is appointed. Additionally, [R.C. 1901.31](#) outlines whether an assistant clerk of courts may be appointed. The 2020 federal decennial census results may change a clerk's position from an appointed position to an elected position. If a board of elections has questions about a specific municipal court clerk position and whether the position is elected or appointed, the board should consult with its legal counsel, the prosecuting attorney, and the municipal court.

### **VI. CITY WARDS**

According to [R.C. 731.06](#), the legislative authority of a city is responsible for subdividing the city into wards within 90 days after the first day of October following the federal decennial census year. Questions about dividing a city into wards should be directed to the city law director or the legislative authority of the city.

### **VII. CITY SCHOOL DISTRICTS**

The minimum number of valid signatures for candidate petitions for a city school district board of education is based upon the total population of the city school district.<sup>6</sup> Please review the attached spreadsheet that reflects the population of all school districts in the state in order to determine the correct number of valid signatures required to be filed for a city school district in

your county, if applicable. Note that this change does not affect petitions already filed for the November 2021 General Election.

### **VIII. CENSUS BLOCKS**

A board of elections may divide any portion of a political subdivision located within its county into precincts and may establish, define, divide, rearrange, and combine the several election precincts within its county. However, a board cannot change the number of precincts or the precinct boundaries during the 25 days immediately preceding a primary or general election, nor between January 1 and the day on which the members of a county central committee of a political party are elected (*i.e.*, May 3, 2022).<sup>7</sup> Precincts must be drawn along census block lines, and those lines change with the release of each federal decennial census.<sup>8</sup> Therefore, boards must work with their county global information system (GIS) coordinators to redraw certain precincts by the end of 2021.

A board of elections may apply in writing to the Secretary of State for a waiver of the census block requirement if drawing precinct boundaries by census blocks is not feasible for either of the following reasons:<sup>9</sup>

- (1) Physical boundaries or residential development practices exist that would cause unusual hardship for voters; or
- (2) A precinct would contain more than 1,400 voters.

Any waiver request must explain in detail why the waiver is needed for a particular block. Additionally, the board's waiver request must include the appropriate map showing the relevant, existing (and proposed, if changed) precinct and census block boundaries.<sup>10</sup> Boards must use the Secretary of State's prescribed [Form 50](#) for this purpose.

### **IX. FEDERAL AND STATE REDISTRICTING**

The number of federal congressional districts apportioned to Ohio is based upon the state's relative population in the federal decennial census. As a result of reapportionment, Ohio is losing one congressional district (reduced from 16 to 15 districts).<sup>11</sup> Ohioans approved constitutional amendments in 2015 and 2018 that change both the federal and state redistricting processes. Article XIX of the Ohio Constitution gives the General Assembly primary responsibility for congressional redistricting. As such, the General Assembly will realign the boundaries of the state's congressional districts in accordance with Article XIX. The Ohio Constitution sets a series of deadlines for the congressional redistricting process, the earliest of which is September 30, 2021.<sup>12</sup>



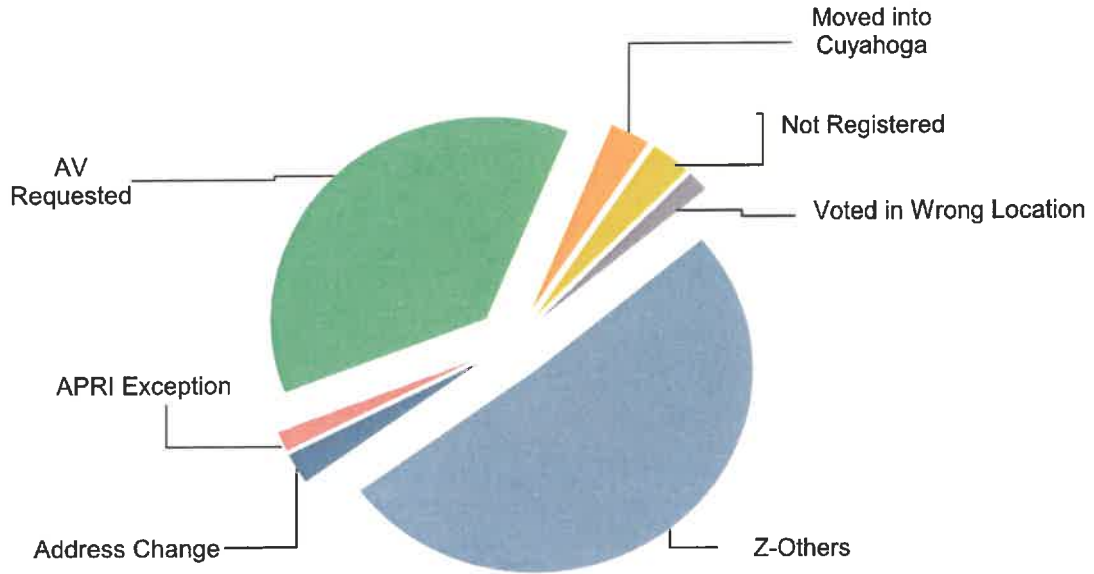
