#### Over-votes

One race was over-voted. The ballot was one of the absentee ballots reviewed by the Board. The decision was to run the ballot "as-is" based on the Ballot Remake Procedure approved on 1/12/2010.

#### **Remade Ballots**

A total of 15 ballots were remade during the tabulation of results for this election. Of these all 15 were Absentee. Members of the Board reviewed 2 Absentee ballots to determine voter intent. The remaining absentee ballots were remade by the Ballot Department based on the Ballot Remake Procedure approved on 1/12/2010. The ballots break down into the following categories:

Torn/Damaged (Scenario 1): 12 Oval Erased (Scenario 4): 1

Darkened Oval (Scenario 2):

1 Board Review/Run "as-is"

#### **Double-voting**

### **Poll Book Justification:**

There are currently 1 precinct where there is a difference between the count of signatures in the poll book and the count of ballots cast. This is precinct Olmsted Falls 4-A, there is one signature less than ballots cast. The ballots match the tabulation of UNITY and there is no information on the pink memo.
